

# Great Smoky Mountain National Park

**\$300**

plus \$5 park fee per vehicle  
covers the \$100 permit fee plus  
\$200 minister fee .



- There is a \$100 permit fee that applies to the cost of your wedding., this is Non- refundable.
- The permit is valid for only 1 hour.
- There is a MAX guest count of 25 people. This includes minister, photographer, bride/groom.
- GSMNP only issues 2 permits per day, so we recommend that once you decide on this location, let us know. However, this location is Non Refundable!
- The location must be booked AT LEAST 30 DAYS IN ADVANCE! If We have to get the permit approved, We will not charge you if it is not approved.
- There is a list of guidelines you must follow, and those will be sent to you once the permit is approved.
- \*\*YOU CAN NOT HIRE YOUR OWN PHOTOGRAPHER (or, minister) TO ANY OF THESE LOCATIONS! GSMNP REQUIRES THEM TO HAVE A CUA LICENSE. The Park WILL fine you if your minister or photographer does not have a special license.

## Greenbrier 1

- There is a “beachy area” that your guest can stand on. There is a bit of an incline to get to this location, not wheelchair accessible.

This location has restrictions to 6p or later from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

## Greenbrier 2

- This is a little further down the stream, more into the park. More of a secluded area. This can be used as a backup if GB1 is unavailable. It is only large enough for a few people.



## Cataract Falls

is a small walk to get to this location. (about the length of half a football field)

It is wheelchair accessible

This location has restrictions to 2pm or later due to tours.
